New Legislation Takes the Spotlight

A5427 - "Eliminates presumption of pretrial release for sex offenses committed against minor." A5275 – "Imposes locational restriction on construction of a new crematory."

After seeing several disturbing articles, I introduced a bill that will prevent any individual who is accused of a sex offense against a minor from being eligible for bail reform and being immediately released back into the public before their trial. It is important that we enact common sense laws that protect the innocent from dangerous people. I am making sure that no one has to worry about a potential threat to their children being free before we are certain that they are innocent. My bill A5427 should give us the peace of mind to sleep at night knowing our communities are safe.

Recently, concerned residents of Robbinsville came to me asking to stop a crematory from being built near Sharon Elementary School. After working with the community to come up with a plan, I introduced my bill A5275. This bill is a solution to a straightforward problem. If the emissions from a crematory are dangerous to public health, we should make sure that they are not able to be built near any public spaces. My bill stops a crematory from being built within 1,000 feet of a school, park, playground, beach, or anywhere zoned as a residential area. Parents and children should not have to worry about the long-lasting affect to public health – they should be focusing on getting an education and what game they will be playing during recess.
